The rate of construction in the UK is ever-increasing, with builders and developers registering a total of 15,343 new homes during October 2019, a year-on-year increase of 6%, and a 10.8% increase in public new work between 2017 and 2018. With a steady growth of new properties and buildings, and following the Grenfell tragedy in 2017, the importance of effective building regulations now has a greater significance in ensuring fire protection. In addition to this, funding cuts to fire and rescue services have resulted in eight out of fourteen fire and rescue services requiring improvement in 2018/19, which puts greater pressure and priority for an effective regulatory framework to monitor the fire safety standards of buildings.

This conference will provide attendees with an invaluable opportunity to hear the latest from government on the Building a Safer Future consultation and the proposals for building safety regulatory reforms. Participants will listen to case studies demonstrating successful approaches to improve fire prevention, including engaging with local communities, fire risk assessments, and local government early adopters of the Hackitt Review recommendations with guidance in training and supporting staff to provide the highest quality of service that can be utilised by you, and your organisation.

She is also a Board member of HS2 Ltd. An engineer by profession, Dame Judith holds a degree in chemical engineering from Imperial College, London..

Andrew has been Editor of *FIRE* magazine since 2000 – 'the trusted voice of fire & emergency'; Editor of *International Fire Professional* – the journal of the Institution of Fire Engineers – since 2012; and founder and host of the Excellence in Fire & Emergency Awards since 2014. Andrew also undertakes voluntary roles such as Communications Director of the Fire Sector Federation, Parliamentary Liaison Officer for the All Party Fire Safety and Rescue Group, and Trustee of the Fire Service Research and Training Trust. In his tenure as Chair of The Fire Fighters Charity, the organisation has seen a significant turnaround with the Harcombe House centre in Devon undergoing a £1.8 million refurbishment and being repurposed to provide physical, mental and social wellbeing support for the whole family. The centre was reopened by His Royal Highness the Duke of Cambridge in September. In July of this year Andrew formed a new company with fire sector colleagues to take over the fire group of products – Fire Knowledge – and is now the Director and Publisher of the magazines and events portfolio which includes an umbrella fire sector consultancy.

## Professor Tim Marsh

Managing Director, Anker and Marsh

Professor Tim Marsh is recognised as a world authority on the subject of behavioural safety, safety leadership and organisational culture. As well as working with many of the world's most recognisable industrial names, Tim has worked with the European Space Agency, the BBC, Sky TV and the National Theatre, and has chaired or key noted dozens of conferences on S,H & W in Europe and around the world. He gave the closing keynote address at the Campbell Institute's inaugural 'international thought leaders' conference in 2014. He has written several books including *Affective Safety Management*, *Talking Safety*, *Organised Well-being*, *Safety Savvy* and *A Definitive Guide to Behavioural Safety*. Tim founded *Ryder-Marsh Safety* in 1994 and is now MD of *Anker & Marsh*.

## Rod McLean

Head of Fire Safety, Home Office

Rod has been head of the Fire Safety Unit since September 2017. The unit is leading the Home Office's response to the Grenfell Tower public inquiry and also has responsibility for fire prevention and protection policy. Rod and his unit are leading on the Fire Safety Bill and changes to the Fire Safety Order as well as working closely with the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government to deliver the systems reform to building and fire safety in high-rise residential and other high-risk buildings recommended in the Hackitt Review.

Rod has been a civil servant since 1999. He started as a fast streamer in the Scottish Executive and then spent three years in Brussels on loan to the Foreign and Commonwealth Office at the UK Permanent Representation to the European Union. With exception of a period at the Ministry of Justice, he has been with the Home Office since 2004. His previous roles include Deputy Director for Judicial Pay and Pensions in the MOJ, Assistant Chief Inspector of Borders and Immigration and head of police forensics and biometrics policy in the Home Office. He holds a first class honours degree in History from Edinburgh University, a doctorate in diplomatic history from the University of Sussex and a Masters degree in Public Policy with Distinction from the London School of Economics.'

## Fleur Priest-Stephens

Policy Leader, National Housing Federation

Fleur leads on the National Housing Federation's *Together with Tenants* framework, working with housing associations to develop strategies that ensure resident oversight and board accountability. Fleur also provides policy support on the Building Safety programme at the NHF. Previously, Fleur has held policy positions in NUS and the Chartered Institute of Housing, with a portfolio covering the private rented sector and student accommodation.
