A Snapshot Of One Day In One County

- 152 individual children came to police attention for a combination of missing person incidents, police intelligence reports and crime occurrences.
- The average age of those children was 11 years. Three of them were under 2.
- 98 of those 152 children had previously been referred to children's social care on at least one occasion.
- 51 of those 152 children were involved in incidents that related to domestic abuse.
- 1 of the most vulnerable of those children from this particular day (a 17 year old girl) has, in the previous 12 months, been arrested 12 times, been reported missing 24 times and been the subject of 157 separate police intelligence reports.
