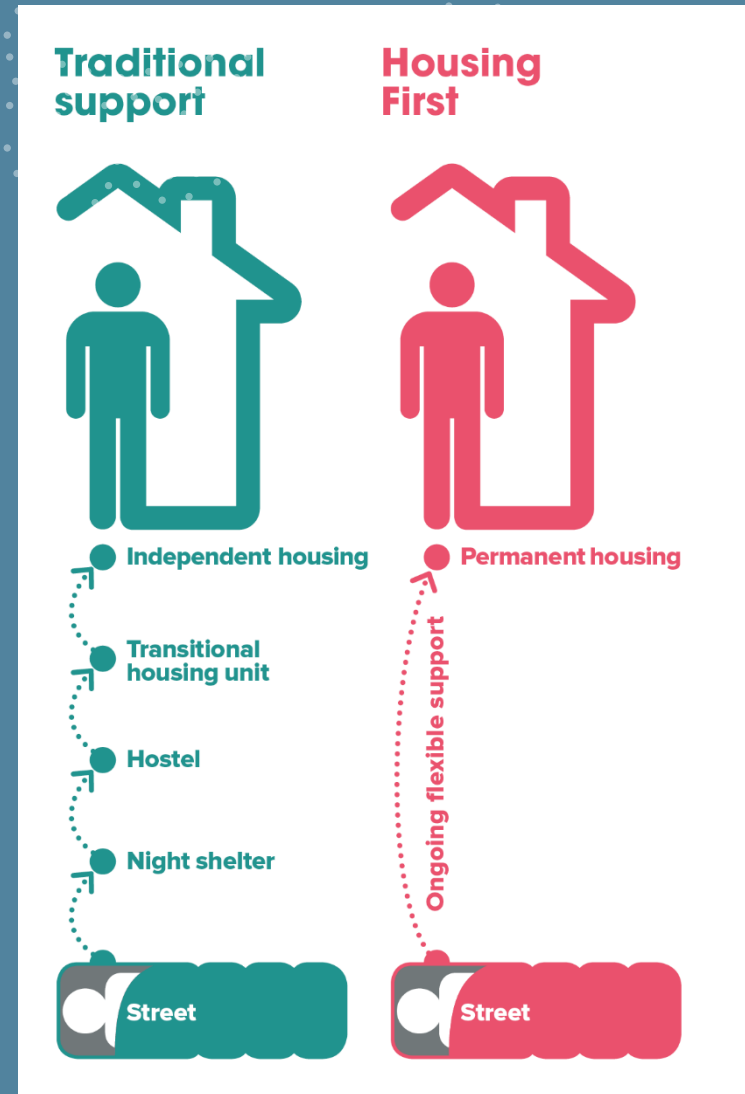
Why would a Housing Association commit to, and invest its own resources in a Housing First Project for young care leavers with complex needs leaving Care?
