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Apprenticeship reform - 2015

- New apprenticeship standards (developed by employers)
- Independent end point assessment
- Length of apprenticeship: minimum 1 year
- Additional requirements for L2 candidates:
 - Maths & English
 - Behaviours
- Funding changes & Levy (end of voluntarist approach)
- Degree Apprenticeships introduced
- Institute of Apprenticeship and Technical Education;
- Government reforms aim to achieve 3 million apprenticeship start ups by 2020.

Recent changes– some examples

- 2020 - to improve **progression and social mobility** across apprenticeships at all levels
- 2021 - government proposing new “**flexi-job**” **apprenticeships**
- 2022 - response to the degree apprenticeships consultation
