Homeless and Health
Inclusion Team Leads

Leeds team

- Sees the patient where they are, In reach, Outreach, Inclusion model
- Identifies patients experiencing homelessness in hospital
- Optimises admission, Specialist assessment by Nurse, OT, GP, Navigator
- Works closely with Transfer of Care hub
- Coordinates and contributes to safe discharge
- Continued casework post hospital discharge, home visiting.
- Out of hospital placements, 9 flats in Transitional housing units, 2 beds in city centre hostel
- Out of hospital team expands the MDT to Specialist Social Worker, Primary Care Outreach, Housing Officer, Support work.
- Gypsy and Traveller outreach
- Host Specialist post leading on multi agency “Our Gaff Leeds” project (formally SHAP)
- Share a Navigator post with St Gemma’s Hospice Health Inclusion team

Jim 51

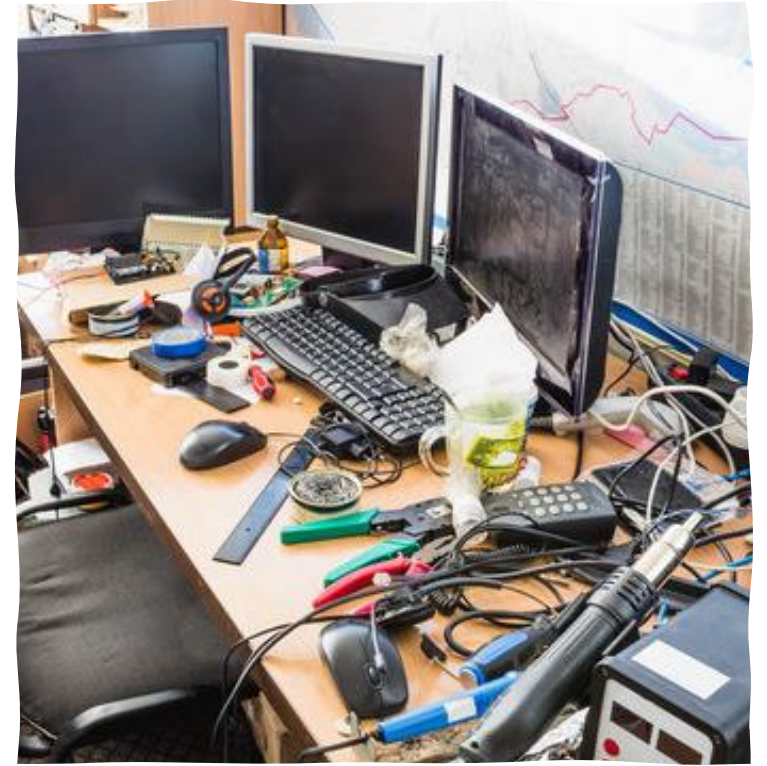
- Edmonton Score 17 (Severely frail)
- Severe COPD
- Asthma
- Alcohol Dependant
- Ascites
- Previous IV drug use, On Opiate Substitute
- Incontinence
- High Intensity User, 8 Admissions to hospital in previous 6 months

Jim

- Discharged from hospital to Leeds housing options as assessed to have no care needs
- Reattended ED 9 times over 1/52 period. Declined accommodation by council due to care needs, assessed as having no care needs by social care. Eventually placed in B&B
- Unable to leave hotel room due to poor mobility, became deconditioned. Referred for out of hospital care. Engaged by specialist outreach teams

Jim

- Accepted by Out of hospital Care. Offered Tenancy.
- Care Act assessment in the community assessed as having care and support needs, full care package offered.
- Continued relationship with Bevan GP and Outreach team
- Reconnected with Mum and family.
- Referred to St Gemma's Health inclusion team.
- Made decision to have palliative care
- Had end of life care in Homeless and Health Intervention bed
- Died at home
