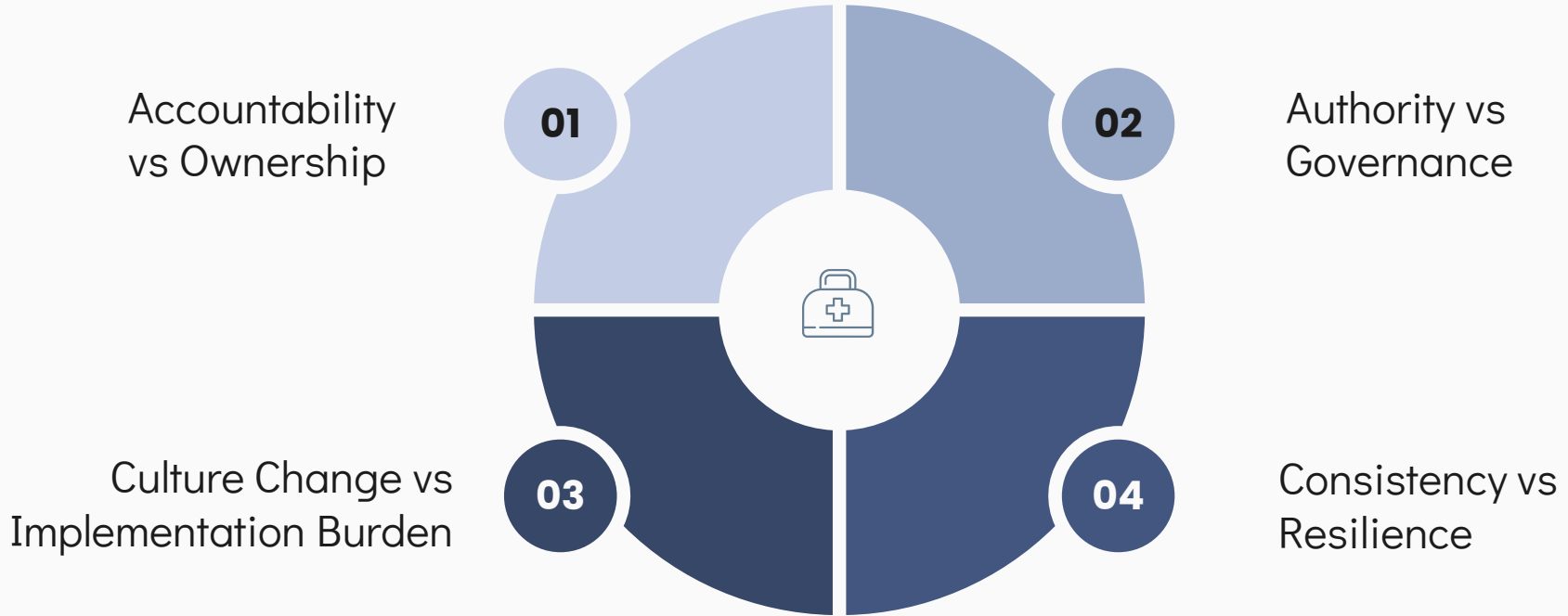

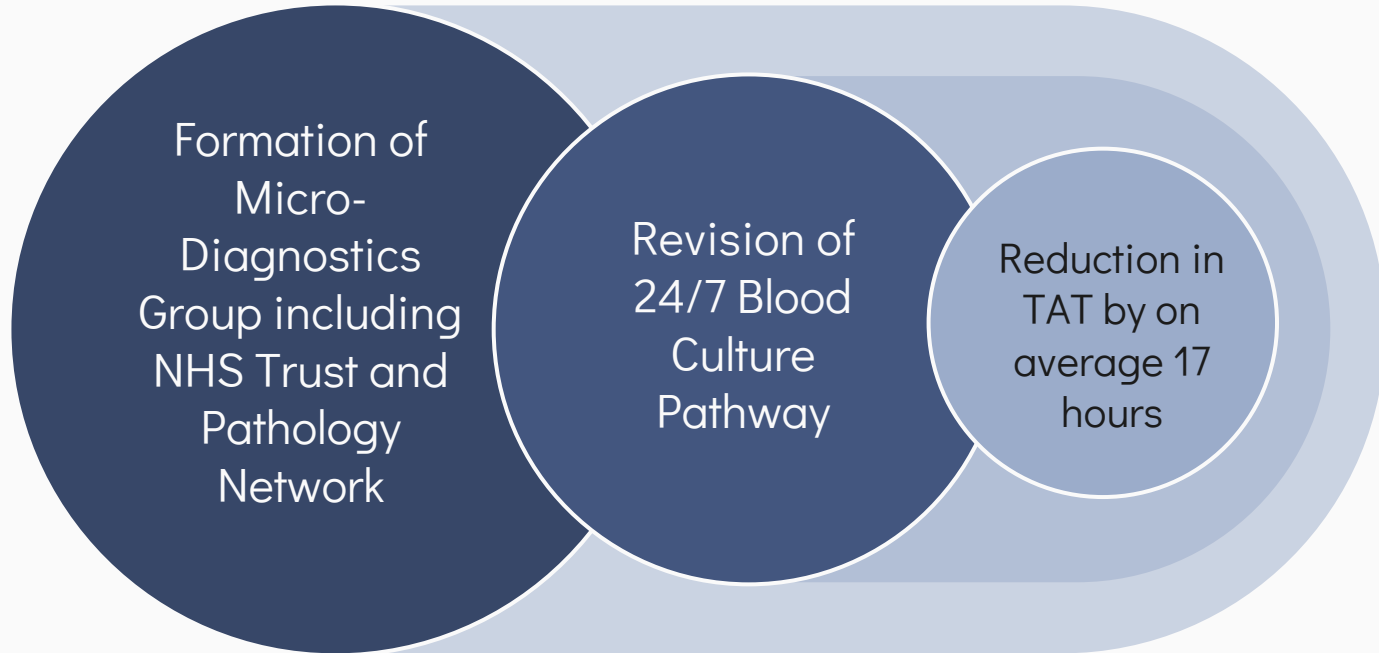

Enhancing sepsis treatment requires strong leadership, collaborative teamwork across departments, and meaningful community engagement to ensure rapid response and improved patient outcomes.

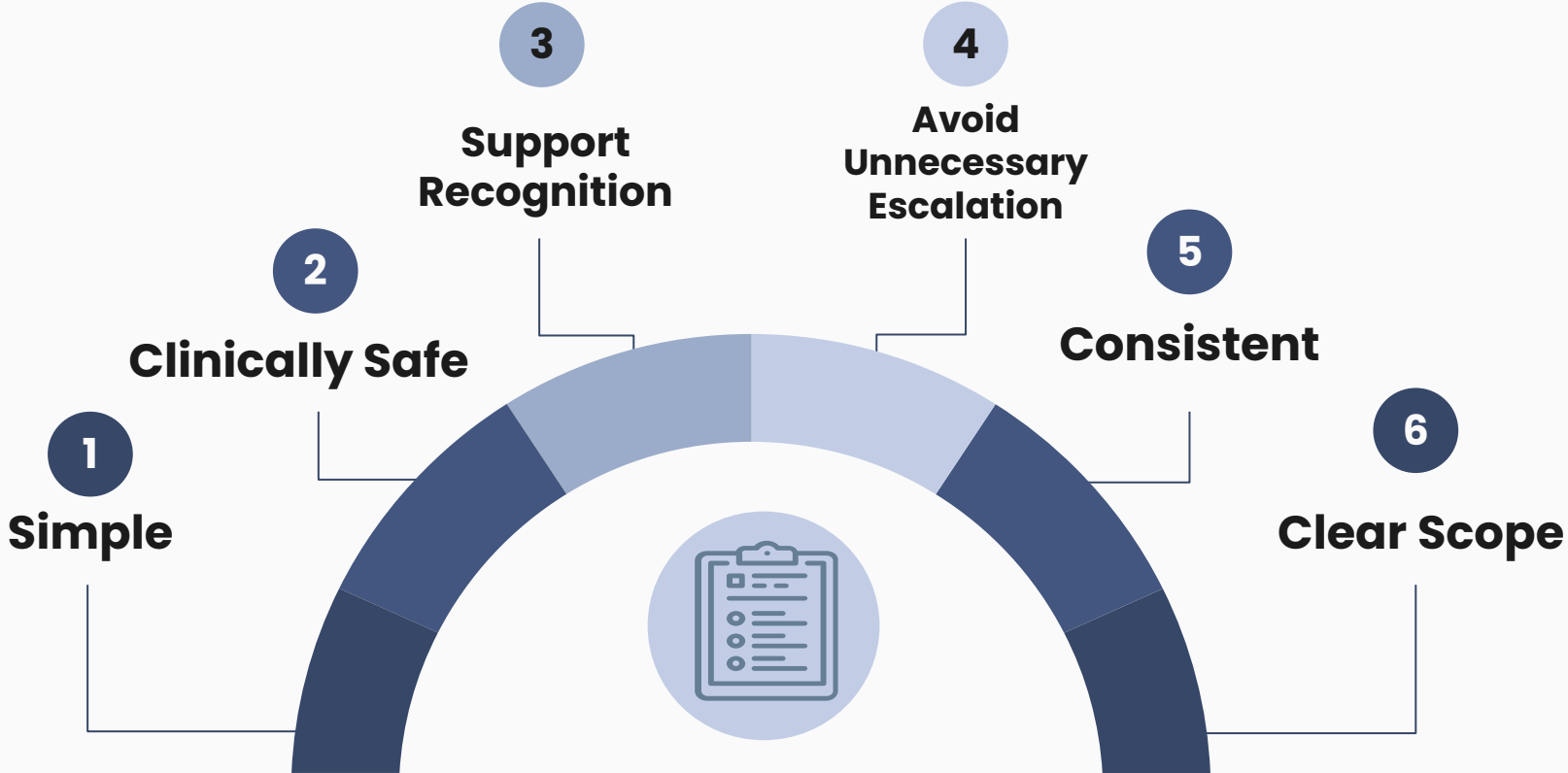
